UConn's Law School is located on a beautiful, collegiate, gothic campus in a pleasant neighborhood of Hartford, Connecticut's capital city.



Academics

Due to visa regulations, the minimum course load required for international exchange students is 9 credits. The average course load for students is 12 credits. Students must also take enough credits to satisfy requirements from their home university. Scan the QR code for information on our courses:

Upon completion of the UConn Law exchange program, exchange students can apply up to 12 credits from their international exchange at UConn Law towards the LL.M. degree 24 credit requirement.
